



WEEKLY SESSION UPDATE

May 20, 2016

With 3 days left in the 2016 Session, legislative leaders have yet to reach an agreement on a number of outstanding issues. A transportation bill and tax bill left from last session are still unresolved. There is no agreement on a supplemental budget bill or a bonding bill at this time. Also, a number of other bills are still being discussed by conference committee.

We will provide you with a final update on the end of session early next week. In the mean time, below is a list of pertinent issues still being considered in conference committee:
